

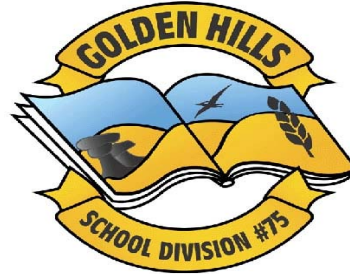
## Safe Committee-

# Our Mandate

▶ As a part of our TOGETHER belief statement for CMJHS, we believe that it is important to use discipline as a positive teaching opportunity for living. In order to waken the virtues within our students, we as a team utilize a consistent and fair approach when dealing with all bullying incidents.

We will often apply the "3 R" approach created by Barbara Coloroso when dealing with bullying matters.

1. **Restitution**- once involved in determining all the issues, we like to examine ways that the bully can "fix" the wrong that has been done.
2. **Resolution**- participants figure out a way to ensure the bully behavior does not happen again.
3. **Reconciliation**- The process of healing that is necessary after a bullying incident

## School code of conduct

We believe each student is a unique individual, and as such it is our responsibility as educators to promote educational success through mutual respect.

Students at CMJHS will...



*Schools Are For Everyone*

1. Conduct themselves in a manner that will not interfere with the learning of others.
2. Attend school regularly, be on time, and be prepared for classes.
3. Conduct themselves in a respectful way with other people.
4. Respect other people's property.

Bullying, harassment and social cruelty will not be tolerated. If students chose to bully they may be involved in one or all of the following:

1. Conflict resolution sessions
2. Counseling provided by the school counselors
3. Referral to the Family School Community Resource Worker program
4. Community/ school service
5. Referral for risk threat assessment thorough Educational Consultants
6. Removal of privileges
7. In extreme cases- suspensions/ removal from school
